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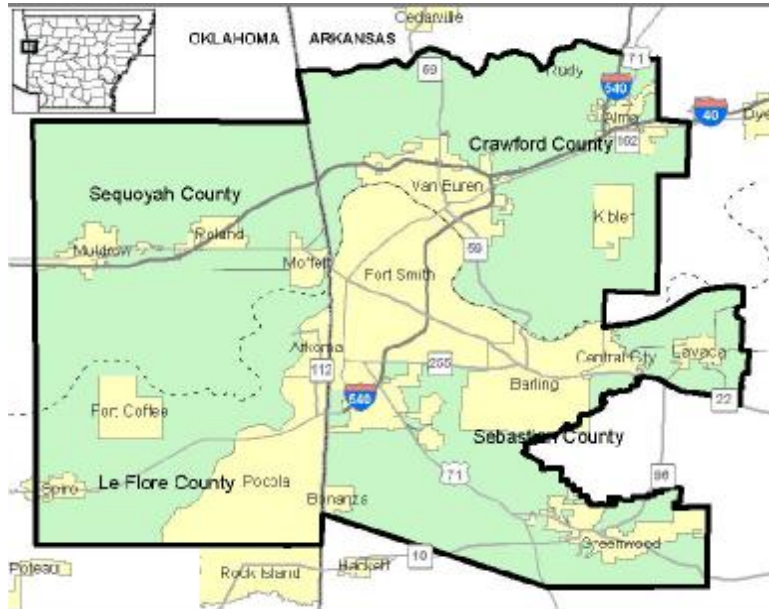
Regulatory Language

As revised by the SAFETEA-LU, 23 U.S.C. 134(j)(7)(B), 23 U.S.C. 135(g)(4)(B), 49 U.S.C. 5303(j)(7)(B), and 49 U.S.C. 5304(g)(4)(B). An Annual Listing of Projects, including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities, for which Federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year shall be published or otherwise made available by the cooperative effort of the State, transit operator, and metropolitan planning organization for public review. The listing shall be consistent with the funding categories identified in each metropolitan transportation improvement program (TIP). The Bi-State Metropolitan Planning Organization has prepared *The Bi-State Metropolitan Planning Organization FY 2009 Annual List of Projects* in accordance with the requirements cited above.

Introduction

The Bi-State Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is responsible for the coordinated transportation planning activities in the Fort Smith/Van Buren Arkansas-Oklahoma Urbanized Area. This geographic area, known as the Bi-State Area, is illustrated in **Map 1**. The Fort Smith/Van Buren Urbanized area comprises the urbanized portions of Crawford and Sebastian Counties in Arkansas and LeFlore and Sequoyah Counties in Oklahoma. The Bi-State Area also includes areas within the Counties identified above that are anticipated to become urbanized within the next 25 years.

The publication of the Bi-State MPO Annual List of Obligated Projects is in accordance with 23 U.S.C. 134(j) (7) (B), 23 U.S.C. 135(g) (4) (B), 49 U.S.C. 5303(j) (7) (B), and 49 U.S.C. 5304(g) (4) (B) as revised by the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) which states: “an Annual Listing of projects, including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities, for which Federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year and shall be published or otherwise made available by the cooperative effort of the State, transit operator, and metropolitan planning organization for public review.
